CRGC ARCHERY FAQ

1. Do you have regular archery programs?

- Yes, we have an active archery community.
- Regularly attended archery practice at outdoor range (Thursday nights weather permitting).
- 3-D Course availability sunrise to sunset 7 days a week.

2. Is instruction available?

- -Yes, beginner through elite, starting as young as Age 5.
- Several adult USA Archery coaches available to assist members, including a former professional archer who is an NTS L4 USA Archery coach.
- There are members available to share knowledge and instruction upon request for a variety of archery related topics including:
- Arrow building,
- Bow maintenance
- Bow tuning
- Proper bow press instruction

3. Does the club provide archery equipment?

- Yes, we offer several sets of youth and adult equipment to learn basic recurve skills. Once member's progress, they typically buy their own equiptment.
- A professional bow press is also available for use with proper instruction.

4. What archery facilities are available at the club?

- Lit outdoor range with archery butts at 10, 20, 30, 40 and 50 ydrs.
- Lit range with 25 animals from 5-50 yds with elevated shooting platform.
- Scenic 3-D wooded course with 28 animals targets throughout 45 acre property.

5. Are there bow hunters at your club?

- Yes, there is a large contingent of both target archers and bow hunters at the club.

6. I am interested in bow hunting, where do I start?

- Semi-annual MA Hunter Education course are available at the club (pending COVID state regulations).
- Mentoring for new hunters is foundational to the club's culture. There are many members willing to mentor and guide individuals new to hunting.

7. Can my child get weekly lessons?

-Group lessons are available at a specific time on most weekends and free to members. Private lessons are available by appointment only for an additional fee. (<u>Currently all archery lessons</u> have been suspended due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic).

8. Can I and/ or my child use your archery range?

-Use of the archery range and facility are reserved for members only. A non-member interested in using the archery facilities must be under the direct supervision of a current club member or sponsor.
